

AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III: DEFINITIONS, LIVESTOCK AND HOUSEHOLD PETS

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOCIAL CIRCLE.

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance may be amended from time to time and the following amendment promotes the health, safety, morals, convenience, and general welfare of Social Circle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council that the Zoning Ordinance is amended as follows:

1. Adding the following definitions to ARTICLE III: DEFINITIONS

"Livestock- any animal raised for food, raw materials or pleasure, and customarily kept on a farm, including but not limited to, beef and dairy cattle, sheep, swine, poultry, horses, mules, donkeys, goats, turkeys, bison, llama, emus and any animal having hooves.


"Household Pets"-domesticated animals weighing less than 150 pounds and cared for by the members of the household and which are not livestock as defined herein.

2. All ordinances, resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this amendment are repealed. This amendment shall become effective immediately upon passage.

3. This amendment is deemed severable, and if any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase or provision of this amendment is found in violation of state law or is adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the remaining portions of this amendment.

READ AND APPROVED December 20, 2016, by the Mayor and Council after public hearing of that date and after a hearing before the Social Circle Planning Commission November 28, 2016, following notice of said hearings published in the Walton and Newton County legal organs 15 to 45 days prior to each hearing.
