**Cherokee Road Bridge Construction to Begin** & Construction on the bridge on South Cherokee Rd at the railroad tracks will begin February 18. S Cherokee will be closed at the bridge during the estimated seven months of construction. Local traffic will be routed down Spring Street. Truck traffic will detour down the bypass.

**Library Tales-for-Tots to Return in March** & Look for upcoming dates, times, and location for the library's popular Tales-For-Tots program to return. **Construction Projects Update**  $\approx$  *N Cherokee Sidewalk:* The sidewalk project was completed with the landscaping along the sidewalk area. *Cherokee Water Line:* Most new waterlines have been flushed and chlorinated. Contractors are connecting long service lines, and concreting and paving trenches on Juniper, West Hightower, and North Cherokee. East Hightower to the bridge will get a new 12" water line and North Forest a new 8" waterline by mid February. Library: Progress is steadily being made on the library renovation and expansion project and we hope that the new library will be ready just in time for the 2019 summer reading program! *S Cherokee Water, and Sewer relocation:* All major lines have been installed and are in the processes of being flushed and chlorinated. The final inspection and new waterlines should be activated by mid February. *Malcom and Fairplay Drive water and sewer project:* Contractors are making steady progress and estimated completion date is mid February. Citizens are urged to be mindful of workers and obey all construction signs for the safety of the workers and citizens.
