**More Ways to Get Your Utility Bill** You may now receive updates about your utility bill via phone, text or email! Please contact City Hall at 770-464-2380 and give us your preferred phone number, email address and cell phone number so we can add them to your account. A copy of your utility bill will be sent to you via email before the bills are mailed out. If your bill is overdue, we can notify you by text message or phone call with the information you will need to pay the bill online to avoid cut-off.

**Help Us Watch Out for Snakes!** Please keep the bushes and grass trimmed around the gas and water meters on your property and keep pine straw away from water meters. This makes it easier to get an accurate reading while avoiding the possibility of snake encounters. The warm winter means more snakes, which are out and about and may be hiding in bushes, pine straw or tall grass.

**Reporting Streetlight Outages** & If you see a streetlight that is out, please report it to Robbie Groves, rgroves@socialcirclega.com, 770-464-6908. Please include the closest street address and pole number and how to get in touch with you if we need more information. Please mark the pole with a ribbon to make it easy to spot when they go to repair it.

**Automated Meter Reading Test Underway** The City is in the process of testing automated meter reading (AMR) on 300 meters installed throughout the City. AMR will make it easy to identify water leaks quickly, allow for more accurate billing and it will allow residents to monitor their own water usage.

**No Garbage Pick-up on Independence Day** ≈ There will be no garbage pick-up on Thursday, July 4. Garbage service will be delayed by one day the rest of the week.

# Congratulations SCHS Class of 2019!

We'd like to recognize the outstanding performance of the 2019 Senior Class:

- 50% have taken at least one college-level course while still in high school. Two seniors earned enough hours to earn an associates degree or the equivalent. Students earned over 1,200 hours of college credit, enabling them to collectively save over \$400,000 in tuition costs.
- Students earned certifications in technology, employability skills, and healthcare fieldsincluding Microsoft Office, Georgia Best, Georgia Tech's LEAP Program in Customer Service, Certified Pharmacy Technician, and Certified Nursing Assistant.
- 74% have been accepted into a total of 54 post-secondary institutions; including colleges and universities in The University System and the Technical College System of Georgia, Emmanuel College, Emory, Mercer, The Naval Academy, Spelman, and West Point.
- In addition to the HOPE scholarship, students earned almost \$1.5 million in scholarships.
- We are proud of our graduates who choose to serve our country by enlisting in the Army/ Marines and those going directly into the workforce to be welders, electricians, landscape designers, home inspectors, retailers, real estate agents, and caretakers of children.
