Annual Summer Burn Ban in Effect A ban on outdoor burning runs from May 1 through Oct 30 in 54 Georgia counties, including Walton County. The GA Forestry Commission will not issue any burn permits for hand piled brush, yard debris, or air curtain destructors. During the hot summer months, ground level ozone increases, which can negatively impact air quality and people's health. Burning yard and land clearing debris may produce smoke and particulate matter that are linked to lung and heart disease in humans. For more information, visit GaTrees.org.

Social Circle PD Receives State Certification & The City of Social Circle Police Department received their State Certification on April 1. Certification status represents a significant professional achievement and acknowledges the implementation of policies and procedures that are conceptually sound and operationally effective.

Social Circle Ranked as 25th Safest City in the State & Social Circle was ranked by Safewise, a pioneer in unbiased home security reviews, as the 25th safest city in Georgia. Their 2019 report of The 50 Safest Cities in Georgia uses FBI crime report statistics and population data to calculate the number of violent crimes and property crimes per 1,000 residents. Last year, Social Circle was ranked 50th and 2017, 25th.

Census 2020 is Coming: Be Counted! See Every 10 years, we count every resident in the United States. The census counts our population and households which provides the basis for distributing more than \$675 billion in federal funds annually to support states, counties and communities' vital programs — impacting housing, education, transportation, employment, health care and public policy. Social Circle will receive \$2300 a year for 10 years for each person in our City.
