**Council Meetings will be Gun-Free** To protect the safety of all, the Social Circle City Council voted to make the monthly Council meetings gun-free starting with the November 19 meeting. Police officers will be present at all meetings. Attendees will enter through the door at the back of the Police Station. Everyone will be scanned before entering or re-entering the Community Room to assure no weapons are brought into the meeting. We appreciate everyone's patience as we implement this practice to enhance the safety of all who attend these meetings.

**Burn Ban Lifted; Permits Required** The temporary ban on all outdoor burning has ended. Georgia Forestry will issue burn permits on a day-by-day basis depending on weather conditions. Burn permits are required for outdoor burning of natural vegetation such as hand piled leafs and limbs and can be obtained at 877-OK2-BURN or online at gatrees.org. Permits must be obtained prior to burning. Campfires and cooking fires are exempt and do not require a permit.

**Georgia EPD Declares Level I Drought Response** & Worsening drought conditions throughout most of the state have prompted a Level 1 Drought Response declaration from the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD). You may only water between 4 pm and 10 am. Personal food gardens, new seeded lawns or turf planted within 30 days may be watered during the day. Drip irrigation and hand watering with a hose or container may also be done at any time. Check our website and Facebook page for further information and tips for water conservation.
