Sewer Line Upgrades in Progress & The City of Social Circle has hired a contractor to replace the existing sewer lines in 3 locations: South Forest Avenue, Tower Road, and Spring Street. The Tower Road Project has been completed. The next area they will work on is Spring Street starting in early January. They will be working in the area behind the residence at 353 Spring Street. Once that is complete they will be working on the right of way in the front yards of the residences between 246 and 302 South Forest Avenue. The project is expected to be complete by February 1, 2018. The purpose of the project is to make the collection system a more efficient utility for the city's current and future needs.
