Playground Coming to Burk Field Thank you to everyone who added input to the design for the playground at Burk Field. The contract has been awarded. The playground will be paid for by \$50,000 in City Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) funds. We will announce the date of the ground-breaking soon. This project success is due to cooperation between the City, community, and the Kiwanis Club of Social Circle.

Budget Document Wins Award The Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) awarded the Distinguished Budget Presentation award to the City for its 2017-2018 budget document. In order to receive the award, the City had to satisfy nationally recognized guidelines for effective budget presentation. The guidelines are designed to assess how well the budget serves as a policy document, financial plan, operational guide and communication device. Budget documents must be rated proficient in all four categories, and in fourteen mandatory criteria within those categories, to receive the award.

Burn Ban in Effect A ban on outdoor runs from May 1 through Oct 30 in 54 Georgia counties, including Walton County and the GA Forestry Commission will not issue any burn permits for hand piled brush, yard debris, or Air Curtain Destructors. During the hot summer months, ground level ozone increases, which can negatively impact air quality and people's health. Burning yard and land clearing debris may produce smoke and particulate matter that are linked to lung and heart disease in humans. For more information, visit GaTrees.org.

Police Department News

Stop Scrollin' and Rollin' The Social Circle Police Department wants to inform the citizens of Social Circle of a very important traffic safety law that is going into effect July 1, 2018. Georgia Governor Nathan Deal signed several bills into law Wednesday May 2, 2018, including the much-anticipated hands-free driving bill. The distracted driving legislation prevents motorist from holding cellphones while behind the wheel of a motor vehicle. However, there are other options that are acceptable under this new "hands-free" law. Some examples are using speaker phone, Bluetooth and earbuds, Siri, Alexa or Cortana while driving. More than a dozen other states have passed similar laws, which resulted in fewer traffic related accidents and fatalities. The Georgia State Patrol, Governor's Office of Highway Safety and the Social Circle Police Department plan a 90-day grace period for drivers beginning in July. During this period drivers will be given warnings to educate citizen of the law, while the public information campaign advertises the changes. Please Don't Flush "Flushable" Wipes Despite the name, "Flushable" wipes are not really flushable. The wipes are made from high strength fibers that do not lose their strength and do not breakdown with time, which can lead to clogs not only in your household lines, but also in City sewer lines. If you use wipes of any kind, please put them in the trash.
