We understand it has been raining this year and the grass grows back as fast as you cut it, so thanks to everyone for keeping Social Circle looking good for our citizens and visitors. Although many issues may be resolved within a matter of days, sometimes it may take up to 90 days to resolve to assure proper notices are given and property owners have an opportunity to fix the code issues.
