The Rebate Rally is a special natural gas appliance event, held by natural gas providers across the state of Georgia each year. Local governments, water heater manufacturers, local contractors, and local businesses have partnered together to promote the understanding of natural gas appliance savings, benefits and efficiencies. Social Circle is participating in the 2017 Rebate Rally Campaign throughout the months of September and October. Promotions include a \$400 rebate on natural gas tankless water heaters, a \$200 rebate on a natural gas tank water heater, \$50 rebate on natural gas stove, lights or logs. The City of Social Circle offers 0% interest financing on the purchase and installation cost of natural gas water heaters, stoves and dryers. Election Signs relection season is upon us, and candidates will soon be placing signs around town. As you may know, all signs are regulated by the City sign ordinance, including political signs. This ordinance allows increased opportunities for signs during these periods, without limiting content. At all times, any sign permitted under this regulation can carry any legal message, political or non-political, commercial or non-commercial, but must follow these regulations: * It is unlawful to place a sign in the right-of-way of any public street or on any public property or building, except signs by an authorized governmental unit. No sign shall be attached to or painted on a telephone pole or power pole, or any tree, rock or other natural object. * It is unlawful to place a sign on any private property unless the owner has given permission to place such sign on such property. * No sign shall be located closer than ten (10) feet from the back of the curb of a public roadway, nor be located closer than ten (10) feet from the public right-of-way. * No sign shall be maintained within 15 feet of an intersection or otherwise placed in a location that limits sight distance. * The total surface area of signs placed on a residential property (zoned R-15, R-25, RMD and RHD) shall not exceed 6 square feet. *The total area of signs on property zoned OI, NC, GC, I-1, and i-2 is not limited during election season, which is defined as the period between the date of qualification for elections until the final determination of all contests and issues. Signs that do not meet the requirements of the Sign Ordinance will be removed, and can be picked up by the candidate or their representative at City Hall.
