**City Safety** The Social Circle Police Department would like to remind everyone of the following 9 p.m. routine in efforts to help prevent crimes of opportunity:

- 1. Remove all valuable items from vehicles. Roll up windows and lock the doors.
- 2. Bring in or secure all valuables in the yard.
- 3. Close overhead garage doors and lock any outside garage doors.
- 4. Close and lock doors on the house.
- 5. Ensure all windows in the house are shut and locked.
- 6. Turn on outside lights.
- 7. Post that you've completed the #9PMRoutine on social media and tag #SCPD.

**Trees and Shrubs** As we enjoy a beautiful summer with ample rain, you may have seen an abundance of new growth from your trees and shrubs. If your plants are growing into the streets or sidewalks, please trim them so that pedestrians and vehicles can safely pass, and that visibility is not obstructed. Thank you for your help in keeping Social Circle beautiful and safe.

**Golf Carts** So Just a reminder to be alert and aware of golf carts on our streets. Golf carts are legal in the city limits where the speed limit is 35mph or lower. You must have a low speed vehicle permit issued by the city.

## **Utility News**

**Utility Rate Increase** The newly approved budget for FY2022 has a slight increase that will be reflected on your August bill.

**Help Keep Our Sewers Healthy** When you dump oil and grease down the drain, the liquid moves through the pipes, cools and hardens, clinging to the sides of the pipe walls causing the pipe circumference to narrow. Eventually, the hardened grease can form a blockage that blocks the pipes in your home or throughout the City causing sewage backups. Please put used fats, oil and grease into containers and put into the garbage.

**Bag Your Grass Clippings and Wet Leaves** The Leaf Vacuum truck is not able to pick up grass clippings (wet or dry) or wet leaves. Please leave the bags for pickup. Do not pile grass clippings with other lawn debris that is left for pickup.

**Gas and Water Meters** Please keep any bushes and grass trimmed around the gas and water meters on your property and keep pine straw away from water meters. This makes it easier to get an accurate reading while avoiding the possibility of snake encounters. The warm winter means more snakes, which are out and about and may be hiding in bushes, pine straw, or tall grass. Also, as a reminder, please do not park vehicles, trailers or anything over the meters.

**Summer Mowing** With the plentiful rain we have had this spring, the grass is growing rapidly. Your City crews are working continually to mow City properties. Please help keep our City looking good by mowing to the curb or street edge in front of your property when you mow your lawn. By working together we can all save tax dollars and contribute to the charm of Social Circle. Thank you for your assistance!

#### **Library News**

Social Circle City Schools have partnered with the W.H. Stanton Memorial Library and AZRLS to bring évery student enrolled in SCCS a library card of their very own! Officially launched in June, the PLAY (PINES Library Access for Youth) digital card provides seamless access to the library's virtual and physical collections. These digital cards are tied to each student's unique school ID and allows them the ability to check out five physical items without being charged overdue fines, with fees only for lost, damaged, or long overdue materials. Some virtual offerings include Tutor.com for live one-to-one tutoring and homework help, Overdrive and the Libby app for eBooks and eAudio, and eREAD Kids eBook collections and research databases via GALILEO.

PLAY eliminates many barriers to access and ensures that all students have the means to access resources and services that support their educational development and growth. Teachers and students may also use PLAY to access library resources directly from the classroom, enabling educators to include the local library as a curriculum resource.

PLAY student patrons are also granted free access to books and other materials in 300 library branches and affiliated service outlets throughout the State of Georgia. Students have access to both physical and digital resources offered by their local libraries, as well as access to library resources in PINES participating libraries throughout the state.
