New City Ordinances Regarding Grass Clippings 🗞

During the November 16th, 2021 Council Meeting, a new ordinance regarding leaves and grass clippings was passed. This ordinance prohibits blowing grass clipping and leaves into roadways, sidewalks, or ditches. This is for everyone's safety. First time violators will be be warned, and continued violation will result in citations. This will be enforced by our Code Enforcement. Please leave within three feet of the curb or road following these restrictions. Please also be aware, yard debris should not obstruct ditchs, sidewalks, or roadways when set out for pickup.

Vacuum Truck - Grass Clippings & Leaves The vacuum truck is now able to vacuum grass clippings. Although the City does still encourage citizens to bag their clippings as often as possible. It is always very important to be sure there is no trash in the piles to be vacuumed up. Trash can cause damage to the machine and can't be properly disposed of with the leaves and clippings. Thank you for helping to keep our city beautiful!

Important Message about Natural Gas Safety \ge Natural gas, America's most popular home heating fuel, is increasingly popular for use by homeowners, schools, businesses, factories and electric power-generation plants because it is efficient, clean, reliable and a relative bargain compared to alternative energy sources. The City of Social Circle provides natural gas to more than 1100 customers through a network of underground distribution lines. Main gas lines, typically 2-inch in diameter, branch into household service lines which are typically half-inch to three-quarter inch in diameter and buried 12- to 18-inches below the surface.

To protect you and others in the community; federal and state government, along with your utility provider have made your safety a high priority. Any time you dig or move earth in any way, you are required to "Call Before You Dig" 48 hours before beginning any digging. When you call 811, they will contact utility owners who will locate all buried utility lines on your property, so you can safely dig and prevent a potentially hazardous condition. Failure to use the 811 system is a known cause of pipeline accidents. Calling before you dig can prevent a costly or even deadly mistake.
