Let freedom ring, celebrate Independence Day

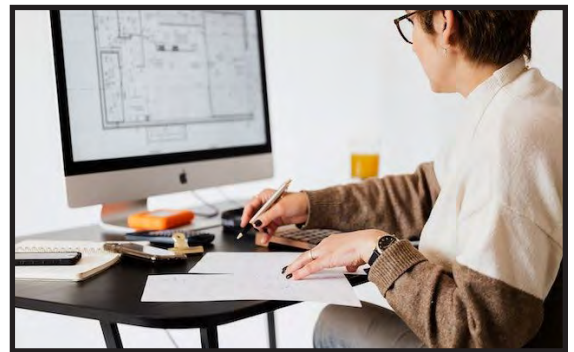

2022 Water Quality Report available

The 2022 Water Quality report is available at socialcirclega.gov. Go to the Residents heading and click on the Public Notices page. Scroll down to Water Quality Reports. Social Circle’s main water source is surface water drawn from the Alcovy River. Our plant can produce one million gallons per day. Water Department staffers test and monitor the water continuously. Monthly samples are sent to the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Environmental Protection Division for testing at state labs. Tests ensure that proper chemical levels are maintained and that the water remains free of contaminants.

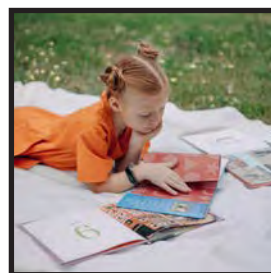
