Speed Limit 35mph in Front of High School The speed limit is now 35mph in front of the High School on Alcova Drive from the roundabout at W Hightower Trail to Laurel. It drops to 25mph in the morning as kids are going to school, and 25 mph in the afternoon as they are being released. Please watch for children and be aware of flashing school zone signs.

Golf Carts Just a reminder to be alert and aware of golf carts on our streets. Golf carts are legal in the city limits where the speed limit is 35mph or lower. You must have a low speed vehicle permit issued by the city. Visit our web site for more information www.socialcirclega.gov.

Service Reminders

We are working to improve our services to you and to make Social Circle a more beautiful city. Here are some reminders of how you can help us collect and dispose of unwanted materials.

Bulk Items Bulk items are collected on the same pick-up day as your designated garbage collection day. We are only able to pick up two (2) household items that, because of the size, do not fit into your 95-gallon cart. Remember, we do not pick up appliances or automotive parts.

Yard Debris We pick up yard debris, such as leaves and sticks, on a different schedule. You can find this information in the <u>Quick Links > Leaf and Brush Collection</u> section of our website. These can be left on the curb, however, grass clippings need to be treated differently. Our equipment is not designed to collect loose grass (or grass left on tarps), and we have unfortunately had to leave some clippings in place at the curb. We need to ask that you place grass clippings in some type of bag that can be entirely collected and hauled away. Plastic bags and paper bags are acceptable.

If you have bagged grass clippings that have [not] been picked up, please call us at 770-464-2380 and we will collect them.
