Special Election on alcohol referendum is Nov. 7

A special election will be held on Nov. 7, 2023, in Social Circle, in conjunction with the General Election, asking voters if they approve issuing licenses for package sales of distilled spirits inside city limits. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. The deadline to register to vote is Oct. 10. Early voting will be held at three locations for the Municipal General Election beginning Oct. 16 and ending Nov. 3: At Felker Park located at 725 S. Madison Ave in Monroe, at Meridian Park located at 105 Generation Blvd in Loganville and at the South Walton Community Room located at 573 Fairplay Rd. in Social Circle. The hours are Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Saturday voting is Oct. 21 and Oct. 28, from 9 a.m.- 5 p.m. at all locations. Disposing of yard debris? Play it safe when burning!

Follow these safety precautions when burning leaf piles and yard debris:

- Keep 25 feet between the fire and woodlands, and 50 feet between the fire and structures,
- Burn during the day, between sunrise and sunset,
- Remain on site of the fire until it is completely extinguished, and there is no risk of embers escaping,
- Have a barrier to contain fire such as bare soil, rocks, bricks, or a burn barrel and a garden hose, rake, or shovel on hand,
- Be alert to National Weather Service warnings and high fire danger.
