City Updates FY2020 Budget Calendar

The City budget is available on the City web site. There will be public hearing opportunity regarding the budget at the June 16 council meeting. Downtown Grants &

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the Social Circle Main Street Commission, Social Circle DDA and Social Circle Foundation stepped up to help businesses in town that were the hardest hit. There were 2 grants established between the 3 groups. The Downtown Grant was established by the Social Circle Main Street Commission and they provided a total of \$17,000 that was distributed amongst 16 businesses. The DDA Stabilization grant was a joint effort by the SCDDA and SC Foundation and they distributed \$13,000 in relief funds to 13 businesses. Thanks to the members of each board for their generosity and willingness to help our Downtown businesses.

Census Committee Seeking Members &

The City Council has adopted a resolution establishing a 2020 Complete Count Committee in support of the 2020 Census. The first meeting will be July 12, which will feature a workshop about the program presented by our census representative. We need people from all over the community to serve on the committee. Water System Upgrade The city will be implementing waterline and water system upgrades near Friendship Park. This project will likely affect traffic flow, therefore, please exercise caution when traveling on South Cherokee in this area.

Community Reminders

CSX Railroad Track Repair ≈ CSX has notified the city that track repair on **Highway 11** is scheduled for **June 17-19, 2020**. While repairs are being made, traffic on the Social Circle Parkway will be detoured through town on North and South Cherokee Road. There will be a hard closure at the railroad tracks and traffic will be unable to cross that intersection.

There will be "No thru truck" signage posted on the parkway with additional detour signs in advance of the closure to route trucks through downtown. The contractor will be in town on Sunday putting our the detour signage.

Please notify your staff and drivers of this closure where possible so that they can be familiar with the detour routes to make deliveries and get to work.
